## STEP 1 Seat Assembly

- Locatethe bench ends (A) and the seat frame (B)
- Insert (2) button head screws (F) with washers (H) thru the bench ends (A) and into the tab on the seat frame (B)
- Secure the bench end tothe seat frame with washers and (H) and hex nuts (G)
- Repeat for the other bench end



## STEP 2 Backrest Assembly

- Hold the backrest assembly (C) in between the bench ends (A)
- The slats are flush to the front side of the assembly
- Align the holes in the bench ends (A) with the holes in backrest assembly (C)
- Insert (2) button head screws (F) with washers (H) through the holes and secure with washers ( H ) and hex nuts (G)
- Repeat for the other side

Step 3 Attach the Seat and Armrests

- Lay the seat slats (D) across the seat frame (B)
- Each seat slat has pre-marked location holes in them
- From the bottom align the holes in the seat frame (B) with the location holes in the seat slats (D) See Detail 1
- $\quad$ Secure the seat slats to the seat frame with \# $10 \times .75$ " pan head screws (I)
- Align the holes in the bench ends (A) with the location holes in the armrests (E)
- $\quad$ Secure the armrests to the bench ends with \#10×.75" pan head screws (I) See Detail 2
